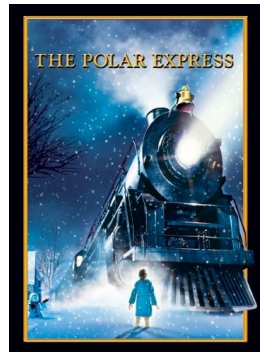


## SUNDOWN CINEMA, NOV 21
