COMMUNITY ART PROJECT PRESENTED

The final result of a community mosaic art project was unveiled Friday, June 19 at 10am at the City of Headland Municipal Complex.

The project began during the Daylily Art & Garden Festival on Headland's downtown square May 16. Mosaic artist Frederic Lecut, a resident of Headland, designed and assembled the pieces into a wall hanging that will be displayed inside the Municipal Complex. The artwork is made up of 20 individual mosaic blocks constructed by students during a children's art workshop at the festival.



The project was sponsored by the Headland Police Department Drug Prevention Program and The Home Depot.

This year's Daylily Art & Garden Festival featured a student art show and contest, art and garden art vendors, gardening exhibits, farmers market vendors, children's art and gardening activities, and performances by the 98th Army Jazz Band, and Headland High School Jazz Band.
